In 1956 General Motors Co. and Chevrolet in particular was at war with Ford Motor Co., working hard to develop a hot looking, public inspired family car that was really fun to drive and look sporty too. This particular model, with the very stylish Bel Air package inside and out was the third most popular Chevrolet built that model year.

The four door sedan was the run-away most popular with an amazing 269,798 rolling off the assembly line, the next most popular two door hardtop model tallying up a respectable 128,382 units. However, the two door sedan seen above was close behind due to its very attractive price tag of \$2,025 and 104,849 total production units. Mary's beautiful Graphite and Pearl '56 has a history. This particular car was garaged for thirty-two (that's 32) years

prior to the Turner's purchasing it. It had not been on the road since 1968. Club Member Al Turner has been working his magic on it for some

time. Fast forward to the present and you will see that it sports new two tone paint. Also, the stainless steel and chrome trim has all be redone. The interior is dressed up with new two tone grey tweed. This very desirable classic comes with a bucket list consisting of soon to be installed power steering, dropped front spindles, power disc brakes and tilt steering column.
